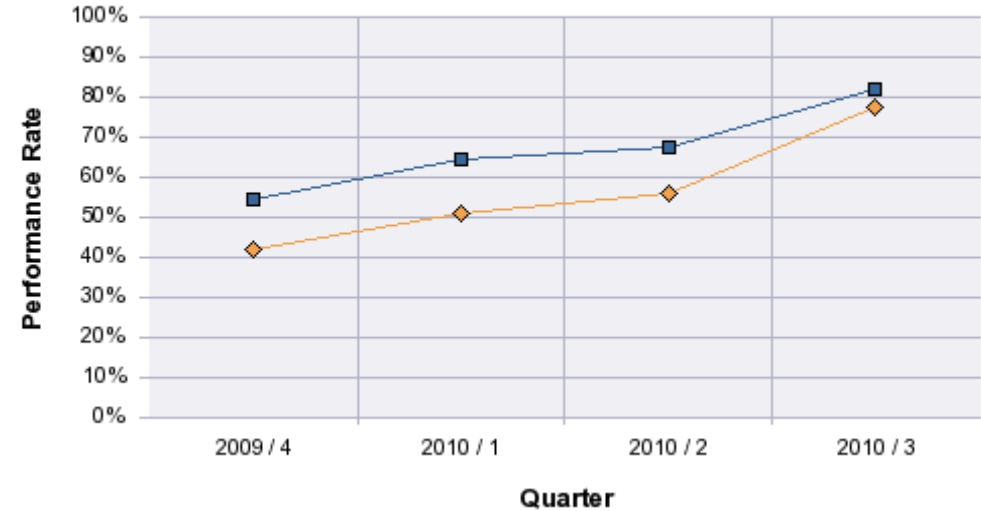

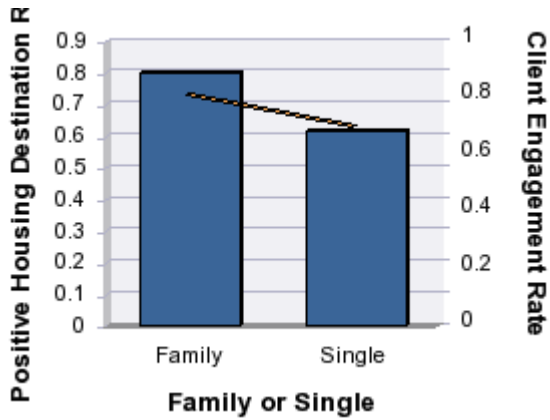

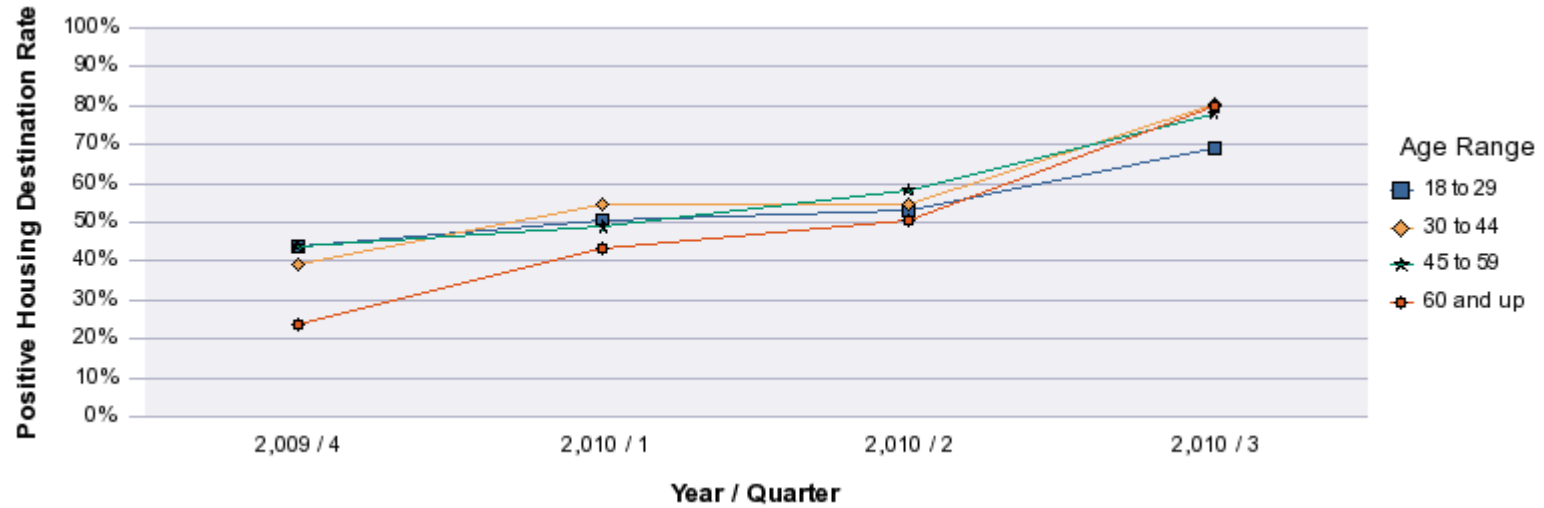

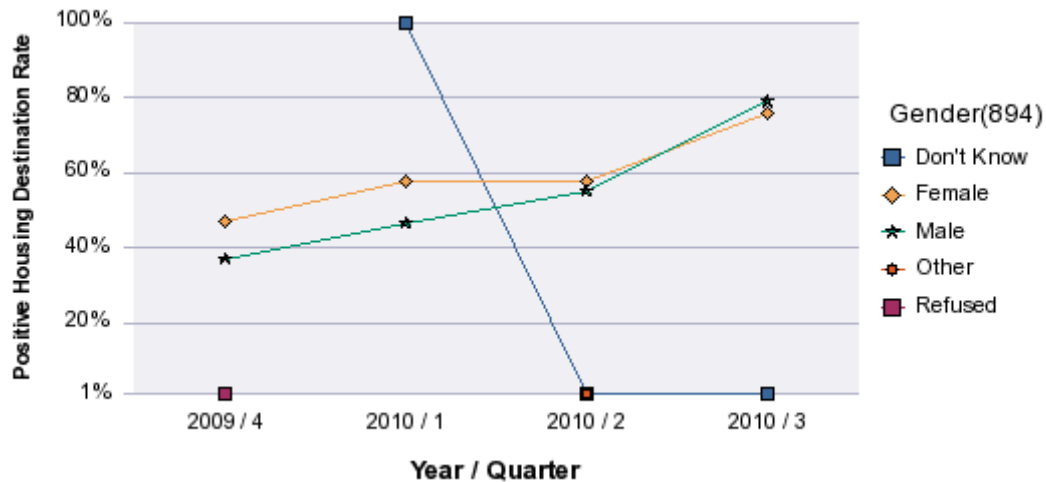


Positive Placement Rate by Age -Adults Only

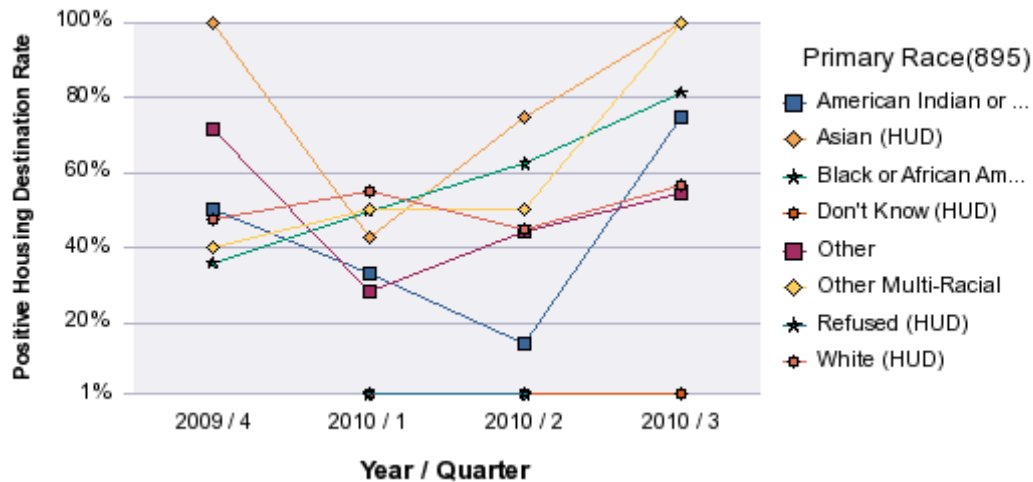

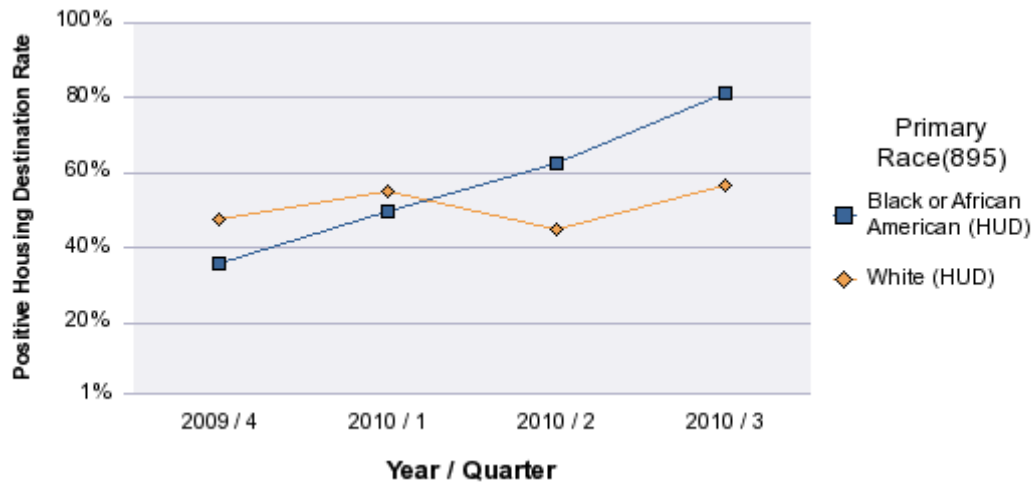

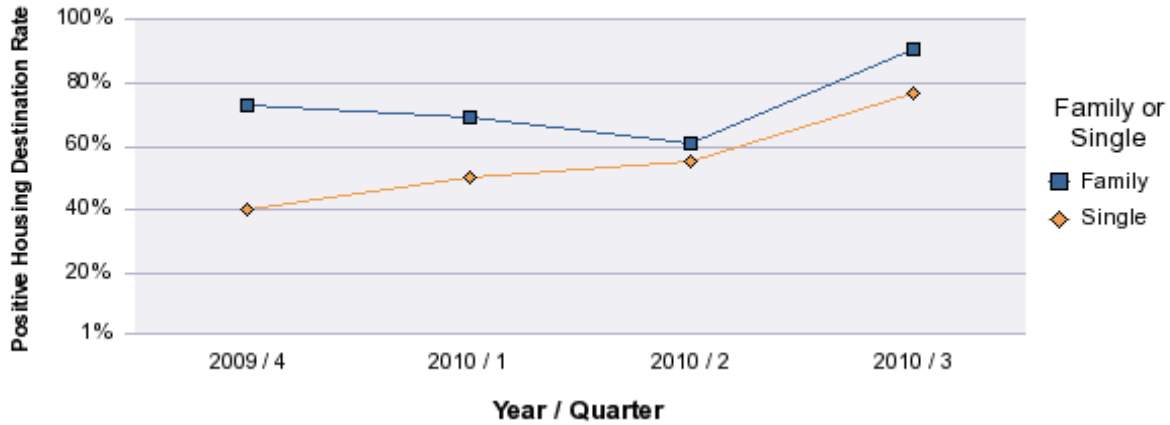

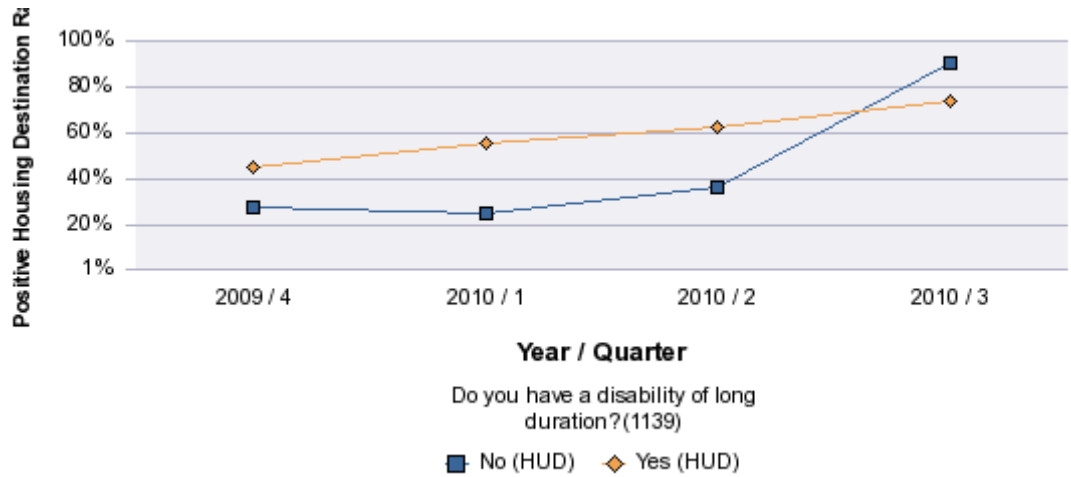

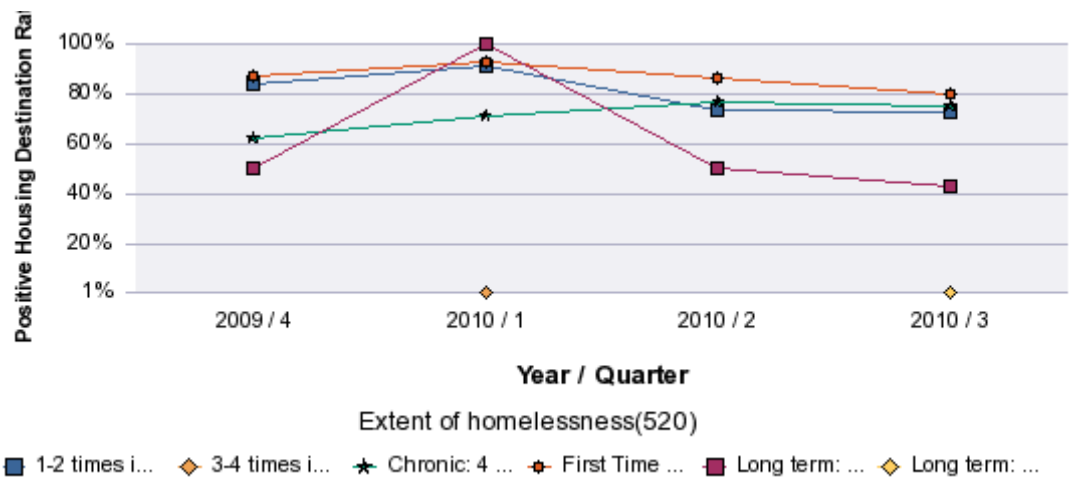

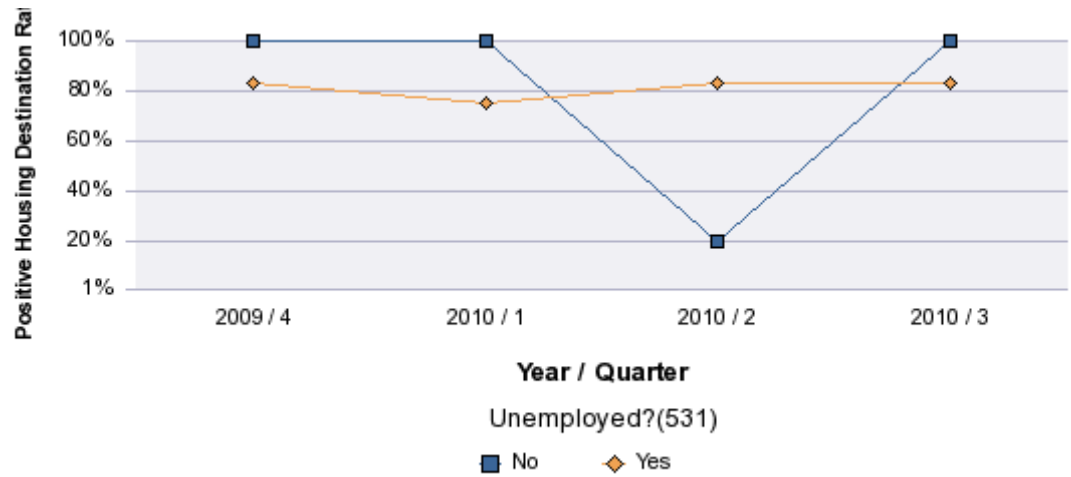

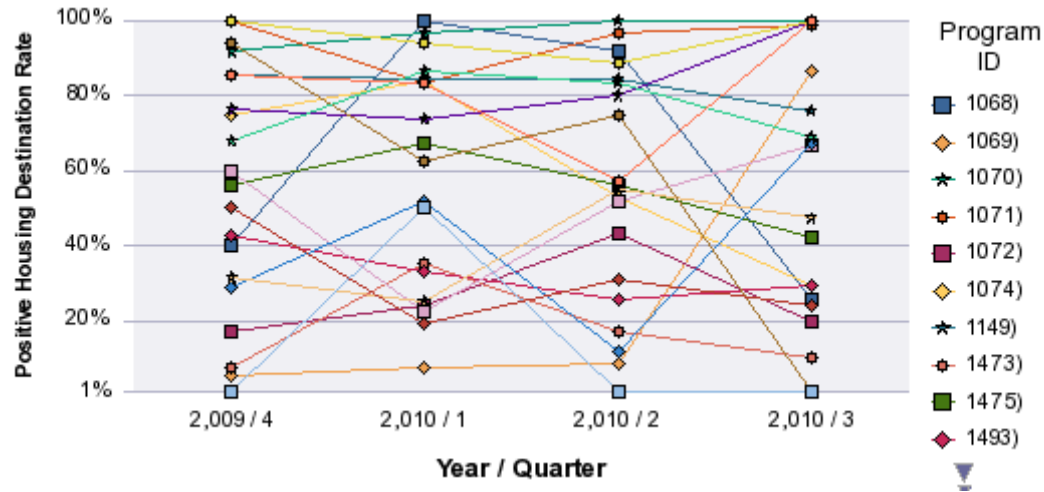
